

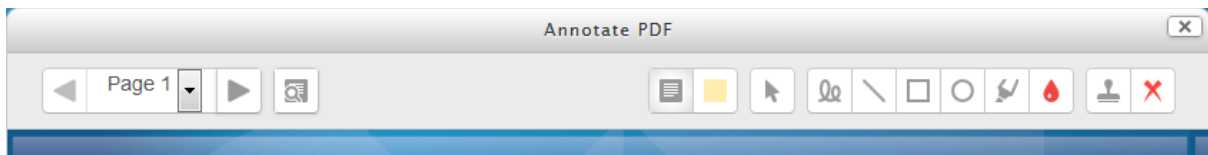
Annotate PDF's

Annotate PDF allows a teacher to annotate and return PDF files that have been submitted to the Assignment tool by students. Teachers can add and position comments and draw lines, ovals, stamps, rectangles and highlights onto the student's work, from within the browser.

If the student has uploaded a PDF file you will see a link to **Launch PDF editor** on the students' individual grading screen.



This will display the PDF inline, allowing you to annotate it, using a variety of tools, stamps and comments.



When the annotations are complete, close the annotator (using the X at the top right, then clicking **Save changes**). This will result in it being displayed to the student as part of their feedback. **(Note that simply clicking on the file itself will not display it inline for annotating.)**

Comments may be added and then saved in a quick list for future use. When adding a new comment, click the icon top right to access previously saved comments:
