








Status Markers - Teachers

What are they?

Status Markers allow students to mark the status of Resources and Activities within their eLearn course. Examples of this include:

- Completed
- Incomplete
- Discuss

The status marker feature is turned on by default.

How to put a status on an activity or resource

Click on the box next to the activity or resource. The range of status markers will appear (like above) and click on the marker you wish to use. This will only be seen by the user.

Status Marker Administration

Click on **Status markers** in the **Administration** block of the course and un-tick the box next to Allow status markers in this course and then save changes.
