

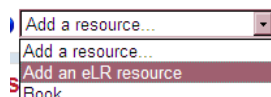


## Attaching an eLR Resource in eLearn


eLR (e-Learning Resources) provides for the flexible storage, search, discovery and retrieval of all file and document types as well as learning objects. Content may include interactive Learning Objects (IMS packages), course content, information on specific areas of interest, teaching and learning strategies, items of curricula, images, sounds, music, video, PDFs and MS Word documents.

Allows you to perform a simple keyword search.
- Power Search**  
Allows you to specify search metadata that is relevant to the type of search you are performing.
- My Favourites**
- Guided Search**  
Allows you to search for items of a specific collection or collections.
- Browse**  
Allows you to browse hierarchy topics.
- Contribute**  
Allows you to contribute an item then select it.
