


Lightbox Gallery

A Lightbox Gallery displays pictures that have been uploaded to eLearn. Pictures can be added by teachers or students. The pictures appear like a filmstrip and when you click on them you are able to zoom in on the image plus the images can be saved as a copy by the students. You can choose to allow comments about the gallery or show extended image information.



Adding a Lightbox gallery to your course:

1. Log into eLearn and click into the course you want to add the activity to.
2. To upload your images into your eLearn course, click on the **Files** link in the **Administration** block. Click on the **Make a folder** button to create a folder. Choose a folder name relevant to your image collection and upload images using the **Upload a file** button into your newly created folder.
** Note: If you want your students to upload images as well, you must choose a folder. Students will not be able to add images to your Lightbox Gallery if **Image directory** is set to **Main files directory**.*
3. Once you have loaded all the files you need, go back to your course and **Turn editing on**. Select **Lightbox gallery** from the drop down menu in the **Add a resource** menu.
4. Fill in the form. When choosing the **Image directory**, choose the folder name you have just created.
5. **Save and display**.



Using the Lightbox Gallery for **ASSESSMENT**

There are two ways to use the Lightbox Gallery for assessment. The first is to have the students comment on the pictures and the second is to have the students add pictures to the gallery.

1. Comments can be added to the Lightbox gallery (select **Yes** when filling out the form). Comments are not anonymous, students can be asked to leave comments or suggestions about the images.
2. For a student to add an image, they click on add an image and follow the prompts to browse and then upload the image.

** Reminder: If you have selected **Main files directory** in the **Image directory** of the settings of the Lightbox gallery, students will not be able to add images. Create a new folder in the files area (instructions on page 1) and link to that.*
