



Using Cloze

From an amateurs point of view!


For short answers only:

- Using the example below, replace the coloured text with the following:
 - The **green** text with your own text
 - The **red** text with the value of the question (if you have one answer, it is 100%, if you have 2 answers, each may be 50% each or 25% and 75%, etc.)
 - The **purple** text with the correct answer (this one will show as an empty box when participants are asked the question)
 - The **blue** text is the feedback (if you want one)

Example:

The colour of snow is {1:SHORTANSWER:%100%white#verygood}

- You will have to repeat these if you want more than one answer per text.
There are other possibilities such as having the answers coming down in “dropping menus”.

CLOZE Instructions from Moodle

Mumbo jumbo if you ask me!

This question consists of some text with an answer embedded right here {1:MULTICHOICE:Wrong answer#Feedback for this wrong answer~Another wrong answer#Feedback for the other wrong answer~=Correct answer#Feedback for correct answer~%50%Answer that gives half the credit#Feedback for half credit answer} and right after that you will have to deal with this short answer {1:SHORTANSWER:Wrong answer#Feedback for this wrong answer~=Correct answer#Feedback for correct answer~%50%Answer that gives half the credit#Feedback for half credit answer} and finally we have a floating point number {2:NUMERICAL:=23.8:0.1#Feedback for correct answer 23.8~%50%23.8:2#Feedback for half credit answer in the nearby region of the correct answer}.

The multichoice question can also be shown in the vertical display of the standard Moodle multiple choice.

{2:MCV:1. Wrong answer#Feedback for this wrong answer~2. Another wrong answer#Feedback for the other wrong answer~=3. Correct answer#Feedback for correct answer~%50%4. Answer that gives half the credit#Feedback for half credit answer}

Or in a horizontal display that is included here in a table.

{2:MCH:a. Wrong answer#Feedback for this wrong answer~b. Another wrong answer#Feedback for the other wrong answer~=c. Correct answer#Feedback for correct answer~%50%d. Answer that gives half the credit#Feedback for half credit answer}

A shortanswer question where case must match. Write Moodle in upper case letters
{1:SHORTANSWER_C:moodle#Feedback for moodle in lower case ~=MOODLE#Feedback for MOODLE in upper case ~%50%Moodle#Feedback for only first letter in upper case}

Note that addresses like www.moodle.org and smileys :-) all work as normal:

- a) How good is this? {1:MULTICHOICE:=Yes#Correct~No#We have a different opinion}
- b) What grade would you give it? {3:NUMERICAL:=3:2}
